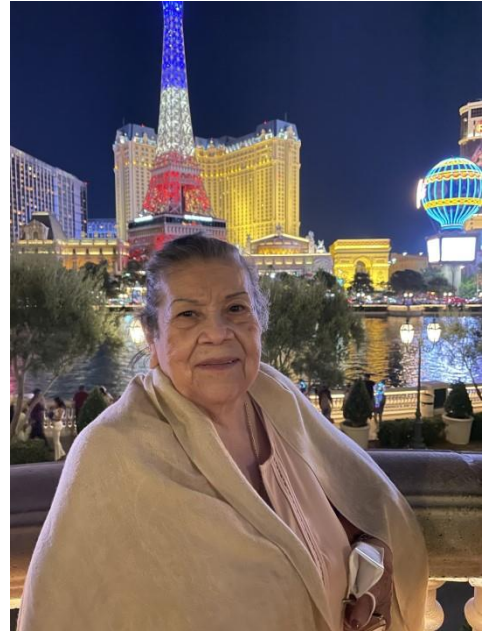


# Maria Auxiliadora Galan
